Project Activities during Nov. 2006 - June 2007

BACKGROUND

- STAPI (earlier known as SOSVA) as a support service organization had implemented the RCH-I Project in the first phase (1998-2002) through 26 FNGOs in 8 districts of Maharashtra Viz Pune, Ahmednagar, Amravati, Dhule, Latur, Nagpur, Nanded & Mumbai.
- SOSVA, our parent organization had implemented a joint partnership UNFPA funded RCH project for improving the status of reproductive health including family planning by strengthening inter sectoral NGOs with support of 15 partner NGOs in 8 districts of Maharashtra viz. Akola, Buldhana, Bhandara, Chandrapur, Gadchiroli, Satara, Osmanabad, Wardha and Yavatmal.
- STAPI as an MNGO is implementing revised RCH II scheme in Pune & Raigad districts of Maharashtra.

OVERVIEW OF THE WORK DONE DURING THE PREPARATORY PHASE -

STAPI has undertaken all the activities & all the necessary procedures during the preparatory phase of the RCH -II scheme. The major activities conducted during the preparatory phase are: -

- Attendance in training workshop on usage of Base Line Survey software organized by the FPAI (RRC)
- Conduct of training workshop on how to organize the Base Line Survey (BLS) for the FNGOs on 08/05/2005. Translation, Printing & Distribution of the Base Line Survey (BLS) forms Procurement, data entry & analysis of filled up forms of the Base Line Survey (BLS) from the FNGOs.
- Conduct of training workshop on proposal development for the FNGOs Finalization & Submission of the Project Proposals to the concerned District RCH Societies on 15-17 Nov 2005 & 24-25 Dec 2005.
- Conduct of Project launching workshop for FNGOs.
- Conduct of grant disbursement workshop for the FNGOs
- Monthly Narrative, Numerical & Financial reporting formats & also the checklist for event documentation were developed.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES OF PARTNER NGOS UNDER REVISED RCH –II PROJECT:

STAPI is implementing Revised RCH-II scheme in Pune & Raigad districts of Maharashtra through support of seven partner NGOs. Composite Proposals for the two districts of Pune and Raigad were sanctioned in July 2006 and the MOU with Member Secretary Executive Committee – District Integrated Health & Family Welfare Societies were signed on 12 & 21 August 2006 respectively. A grant of Rs. 20,08,839/- for Pune District for period of 18 months & a grant of Rs. 14,69,660/- for Raigad District for period of 18 months was released on 16th October 2006. STAPI conducted number of capacity building training programmes for seven partner NGOs which focused on issues like effective Coordination among MNGOs - FNGOs and state RCH welfare society, Roles and Responsibilities of FNGOs implementing RCH project, Coordination between DHO office and NGOs implementing RCH project in Pune & Raigad District, Interaction between Regional Resource Centre and NGOs implementing RCH project, Activity planning, Maintenance of project accounts, Monitoring and Evaluation, technical sessions like Adolescent Health etc. More details on various capacity building trainings under Revised RCH-II scheme are given below.

Additional Initiatives:

- The monthly English Reporting formats provided by RRC were translated in Marathi.
- The Micro planning of FNGO Activities was done during the project-launching workshop
- The FNGOs also had the opportunity to interact with the SFWB'S Officials in the Month of May 06 even before the sanction of the project.
- STAPI also organized a joint meeting between DHO Raigad & FNGOS from Raigad District in the month of March 06.
- The NGOs from Raigad district were also involved in a short assignment of conduct of various advocacy meetings with CBO's, Private and Resident Medical Practitioners and Decision makers under the Global Fund Round III in Raigad District.
- For ensuring effective programme implementation and co-ordination between programme and finance, STAPI is planning to conduct an audit for the period Sept 06 to March 2007 of all partner NGOS . Once this is over, then STAPI will conduct regular quarterly audit of all the partner NGOs from April 2007.
- STAPI also organised a midterm review meeting with the project holders and Project co-coordinators in the Month of February 2007. It helped the MNGO to understand filed difficulties of Partner NGOs. We in turn could helped and guided the Partner NGOs in addressing and finding solution to their difficulties. Some of the important issues came up such as need for revision of budget, need for increase in salaries of Project Staff, more active support from Government etc.
- For ensuring effective programme implementation and co-ordination between programme and finance, STAPI has initiated internal financial audit of the partner NGOs

Collaborative efforts with Government functionaries of Maharashtra State.

STAPI has been working in collaboration with respective District RCH Societies & the Regional Resource Centre to ensure an effective Government- NGO collaboration at field level. STAPI has also initiated communication with the PRI members. FNGOs are requested to act as a 'Peer Groups' in the implementation of various activities under RCH II project in both the districts.

Collection of IEC material on Reproductive and Child Health

STAPI has procured IEC material from the IEC Bureau, which includes RCH guidebooks (translated in Marathi), flip charts, leaflets, banners, and posters. Some of which has already been distributed to Project Coordinators and Village Health Workers.
