The Governing Council of Sosva Training and Promotion Institute (STAPI) takes great pleasure in presenting its Twentieth Annual Report together with the audited statements of accounts for the financial year 2019-2020.

STAPI as a support service organization, continued to offer a wide variety of valuable services to the NGOs in Maharashtra, maintaining a close association with all its partnering organizations and partner NGOs during the period under report.

For the Twentieth year in succession, STAPI continued its systematic efforts for increase in its outreach and upgrading the scope and quality of services it offers to the NGOs.

The year witnessed STAPI's partnership with Tribal Research and Training Institute (TRTI) for operational research for exploring local livelihood opportunities for the tribal youth in the age group of 18-35 from Chikhaldara and Dharani Blocks of Amravati District and Jiwati Block of Chandrapur District with focus on health and nutrition aspects under its Entrepreneurship Social Development Project (ESDP).

The year also witnessed Social and Environmental Audits in 35 villages of Pune and Satara Districts under JalSwarajya-II Projects.

Meetings of Governing Council and General Body of the Society:-

The Governing Council met on 3 occasions during 49th Meetings of the Governing Council held at STAPI on 10/9/2019, The 19th Annual General Meeting of STAPI held at STAPI on 10/9/2019 and 33rd Core Committee Meeting held at STAPI on 10/9/2019.

I) Training Activities : An Overview :-

A total of 15 trainings were organized during April 2019- March 2020. Details on training activities and project wise trainings details are provided at Annexures 1, 2 & 3 respectively.

II) About Projects:-

1) Community Based Monitoring and Planning Processes Project (CBMP) with the support of National Health Mission(NHM), Mumbai and Technical support by State Health Systems Resource Centre (SHSRC)

The geographical coverage of CBMP project is 228 villages and 28 PHC's from four districts of Maharashtra. Raigad (54 Villages-07 PHC's), Ahmednagar (66 Villages-07 PHC's) Amravati (55 Villages 07 PHC's) and Chandrapur (54 Villages 07 PHC's).

The various activities under Community Based Monitoring and Planning Processes Project included :-

- ❖ Participation in 27 JANSAMVAD's (21 PHC level, 04 Block level and 02 District level)
- ❖ 80 Health GramSabha's covering 08 blocks and 4 districts of Maharashtra
- ❖ 19 PHC level Social Audits in 6 blocks and 4 districts of Maharashtra
- ❖ 04 district level Decentralized Health Planning Meetings (One Meeting Per District)
- ❖ 04 block level DHP Meetings (Chandrapur, Ahmednagar, Sangamner, Chandur Railway blocks of Chandrapur, Ahmednagar and Amravati Districts respectively)
- ❖ 39 Mentoring and Monitoring Committee Meetings - (27 PHC level covering 8 blocks of 4 districts); (08 Block level covering 7 blocks of 4 districts); (3 District level Ahmednagar, Raigad and Chandrapur Districts) and one State level Mentoring Meeting.

STAPI as an 'State Nodal NGO' for CBMP Project organized 04 capacity building training's for block and district partner NGO's, Village/PHC/Block/District level field visits for hand holding support and supportive supervision of 8 block partner NGOs and 4 district partner NGOs from Raigad, Ahmednagar, Amravati and Chandrapur Districts of Maharashtra. More details are at Annexures 1 and 4 respectively.

2) Project SWAVALAMBAN - Socio - Economic Empowerment of Fisherman Community at Samata Nagar, Village Tardobachi Wadi, Block Shirur, District Pune:-

The activities in the areas of Sanitation, Women Empowerment and Education included the following. More details are at Annexure 2.

A) Sanitation:-

The Samata Nagar cluster is 100% open defecation free due to mind set change towards regular use and maintenance community and household toilets of the community.

B) Women Empowerment :-

- i) Regular Conduct of Monthly Meetings of 7 Women and 2 Male Self Help Groups
- ii) Conduct of 04 Vocational Skill Training's in the areas of tailoring, fashion designing, kitchen gardening and broom making during August 2019-March 2020
 - a) 14 SHG Members from 6 SHG's trained in tailoring during August-November 2019
 - b) 12 SHG Members from 6 SHG's trained in fashion designing during November 2019-January 2020
 - c) 10 SHG Members from 6 SHG's trained in Kitchen Gardening during November 2019- January 2020
 - d) 14 SHG Members from 6 SHG's trained in broom making during February 2020
- iii) 23 SHG Members from 7 SHG's started various income generation activities
- iv) Regular sessions with pregnant and lactating Women in reproductive and child health and sessions with 24 adolescent girls in adolescent reproductive sex health education

C) Activities with Male Youth:-

Two Youth Self Help Groups (22 Male Youth) were formed during the period under report.

D) Education:- ICDS Activities:-

- i) The refurbished and upgraded Aanganwadi helped in enabling environment in child friendly Aanganwadi.
- ii) The local community female youth as a supporting hand to the Aanganwadi have demonstrated strong community accountability and ownership.

Education:- Primary Education:-

The local transportation arrangements for 30 children studying in 5th-10th standard was provided during the period under report. This arrangements helped in reduction of frequent absenteeism in schools and enhancement in quality of education. It is noteworthy that the parents took the collective responsibility of ensuring regular school attendance of their children

E) Safe and Secure Drinking Water Supply:-

As a part of JS-II Pune Project, 65 households started availing the tap water through household water meter connection.

F) Access and Availment of Government schemes:-

- i) Availment of Pradhan Mantri Gramin Awas Yojana (PMGAY)- Housing for rural poor to 11 Households at Samata Nagar; 4 Households under Shabari Adim Gharkul Yojana
- ii) Availment of Revolving Funds to 6 Self Help Groups from Panchayat Samiti Block Shirur

3) Targeted Intervention Project 'DOSTI' with 20,000 Migrants (Loom Workers) in Bhivandi Block Thane District :-

Activities like conduct of 228 Health Camps, 9 Street Plays, 12 Advocacy Meetings, 12 Demand Generation Activities and 7 Congregation Events were organized during April 2019- March 2020.

The annual project evaluation was conducted during 12-13 January 2020. MSACS and NACO conducted financial audits on 08/06/2019 and on 07/12/2019 respectively. More Details on project activities are at Annexure 5.

4) Operational Research in Entrepreneurship Social Development Project (ESDP) with Tribal Research and Training Institute (TRTI) :-

Tribal Research and Training Institute (TRTI), supported operational research for exploring local livelihood opportunities focusing on health and nutrition aspects) for local tribal youth in the age group of 18-35 in 35 project villages of Amravati District (Dharani -10 villages, Chikhaldara - 07 Villages) and Chandrapur District (Jiwati Block -18 Villages) of Maharashtra. The activities included:-

- 1) Baseline Survey of 35 villages of Dharani, Chikhaldara blocks of Amravati District and Jiwati Block of Chandrapur District
- 2) Focus Group Discussions (FGD's) with:-
 - a) ASHA/ANM/ MPW / ICDS Staff on Public Health issues
 - b) Members of School Management Committees at District and School level, Centre in Charge at Block Level on status of quality of education and reasons for school dropouts at the village level
 - c) Members of the Grampanchayat's and Members of various village level committees for understanding services and schemes availment at the village level
 - d) Members of Self Help Groups (SHG's) to understand socio-economic empowerment of village women and their involvement and participation in various village level activities, Youth Groups (Male and Female) to understand and assess their present status and occupation
 - e) Youth Mandals, Youth Groups and Networks
- 3) Key informant Interviews (KII) with Programme Officers ITDP, Block Development Officers, Block Health Officers, Block Education Officers, Village Development Officers/Gramsevak's Sarpanch and Police Patil
- 4) Conduct of 6 Training's attended by 274 local tribal youth (in the age group of 18-35) from Chikhaldara, Dharani and Jiwati Blocks of Amravati and Chandrapur districts respectively

5) Jalswarajya II Project – Pune District :-

STAPI as Support Organization (SO) for Pune District implemented JS-II Project in 70 priority villages. Peri-Urban Villages (06), Water Stressed Villages (20), Water Quality Affected Villages (22) and Aquifer Villages (22) from 14 blocks of Pune District since April 2015.

The JS-II Pune Project Commenced in April 2015 came to an end in March 2020.

The project activities focused on ensuring improved access to quality and sustainable water and sanitation services in peri-urban villages and safe drinking water in water quality and water stressed villages aiming at safe and secure water systems at the communities level.

The project activities included IEC and BCC initiatives with local population of 70 priority villages and with Ground Water Management Associations, Capacity building of observation wells owners in measurement and recording of water level and rainfall monitoring, Participation in district level water management and planning meetings for water distribution and cropping pattern in aquifer villages, Strengthening of Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Committees,

Social Audit and Women Development Committees, Participation in Gramsabha's, Joint Review Meetings with Reform Support and Project Management Unit (RSPMU), Department of Water and Sanitation, Govt. of Maharashtra, Ground Water Survey and Development Agency (GSDA) Pune, Maharashtra Jeevan Pradhikaran Pune and Zilla Parishad Pune.

6) Jalswarajya II Project –Satara District :-

STAPI as Support Organization (SO) for Satara District implemented JS-II Project in 97 priority villages-Peri-Urban Villages (8), Water Stressed Villages(74), Water Quality Village(1) and Aquifer Villages (14) from 11 blocks of Satara District.

The JS-II Satara Project commenced in October 2018 came to an end in March 2020.

The project activities included Village level committees meetings and training's, ward-wise and corner meetings, Meetings with SHG Members and Youth, Study cum exposure visits, Baseline survey in Peri-Urban Village Bilhar (Village of Books), Block Mahabaleshwar, Participation in Gramsabha's, Strengthening of Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Committees, Social Audit and Women Development Committees, Focus Group Discussions, Capacity building of observation wells owners from 14 aquifer Villages of Phaltan block in measurement and recording of water level and rainfall monitoring, Joint Review Meetings with Reform Support and Project Management Unit (RSPMU) Department of Water and Sanitation, Govt of Maharashtra, Ground Water Survey and Development Agency (GSDA) Satara, Maharashtra Jeevan Pradhikaran Satara and Zilla Parishad Satara.

Social and Environmental Audits in Pune and Satara Districts under Jalswarajya II Project :-

The Social Audits were conducted through group and individual interactions with Scheme contractor, Members of Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Committees, Social Audit and Women Development Committees including the scheme beneficiaries.

Total of 35 Social Audits (Pune 20 and Satara 15) were conduct during the period under report.

The findings, experiences, and learning's of each phase including 'Best Practices' were shared and reviewed with all the stakeholders.

Social Audit Activities in Pune and Satara Districts under under Jalswarajya II Project helped in

- ❖ Assessing people's participation in programme sustenance and ensure adherence to social management principles of inclusion, equity, cost-effectiveness, transparency and environmental soundness etc.
- ❖ Assessing the adequacy and effectiveness of planning of implementation of Jalswarajya-II Project viz efficacy of system of allocation, release and utilization of fund in efficient manner; Economical Efficient and Effective implementation of the scheme and community ownership.

2) Independent Verification Processes were conducted in 16 Villages of Pune and Satara Districts. The 10 Villages of Pune District covering (06 Peri-Urban Villages); (03 Water Stressed Villages) and (One Water Quality Affected Village) and 6 Villages of Satara District covering (02 Peri-Urban Villages) and (4 Water Stressed Villages)

The objective of the IVA visits was to address the needs of water- stressed and water quality affected areas, managing drinking water quality, and ensuring drinking water security in the face of increasing droughts.

The activities under IVA included document review for sampling strategy and assessment of schemes, Identification of sample schemes for site visits, Desk Verification of the scheme, Site visits to community safe and secure water system, Providing verification opinion to the concerned stakeholders.

7) Partnership with Indiana Group :-

Indiana Group supported Needs Assessment Study in 5 villages of Purandar Block of Pune District. The activities included Baseline Survey's, Focus Groups Discussions and key Informant Interviews.

Resource Mobilization: -

STAPI is grateful to all its donors and partners for their valuable support. The details on individuals and institutional donors, and project grants are provided at Annexure 6.

Linkages & Networking with Other Organizations:-

STAPI has strong linkages and networking with several partners viz NGO Networks across Maharashtra, Central and State Government Agencies - Maharashtra State Health Services, State Health and Family Welfare Bureau, District and Block Health Officers, Medical Officers Primary Health Care Centres, Panchayat Samiti's across Maharashtra and Experts from State AIDS Control Societies and Management Institutions.

The geographical network has greatly enhanced STAPI's outreach and as a result of which many NGOs have been able to access STAPI Services. STAPI also has a good network with the Donors Well-Wishers, Members of various Projects Advisory Committees and Volunteers.
