## **SOSVA Training And Promotion Institute (STAPI)**

### **Annual Report - 2024 - 2025**

The Governing Council of SOSVA Training and Promotion Institute (STAPI) takes pleasure in presenting its Twenty Fifth Annual Report together with the Audited Statement of Accounts for the financial year 2024-2025.

STAPI as a support service organization, continued to offer a wide variety of services to the NGOs in Maharashtra, maintaining a close association with all its partnering organizations and partner NGOs during the year 2024-2025.

For the Twenty Fifth year in succession, STAPI continued its systematic efforts for increase in its outreach and upgrading the scope and quality of services it offers to the NGOs.

The year witnessed launch of project " School Chale Hum" - educational support to the non-institutionalized orphan children (age group 13-23 who lost both/single parents due to COVID 19) with the Support of YARDI Solutions Pvt Ltd Pune.

The educational support project for non-institutionalized orphan children (age group 13-17) who lost both/single parents due to COVID 19) for Palghar district with the support of R.V.Naik Memorial Trust - IDBI Trusteeship Services Limited Satara was further extended during the year 2024-2025.

The year also witnessed scaling up of Epic Maharashtra Project to selected 20 MSACSTI Partner NGOs/CSOs from 18 districts of Maharashtra.

#### **Meetings of Governing Council and General Body of the Society :-**

The Governing Council met on 71<sup>st</sup>, 72<sup>nd</sup> and 73<sup>rd</sup> Meetings of the Governing Council held on 3/8/2024, 28/9/2024 and on 19/2/2025 respectively at Pune. The 24<sup>th</sup> Annual General Body meeting was held on 28/9/2024 at Pune.

### About Projects:

#### 1) EpiC Maharashtra Project for technical assistance (TA) in organizational development (OD) to KP serving CSO's, KP led CBO's, and PLHIV Networks with the support of FHI 360 and USAID :-

STAPI as a "Lead Partner" for EpiC project is involved in organisational development as technical assistance to (KP) serving CSO's, KP led CBO's, and PLHIV Networks since June 2021.

The project aims to improve the organizational capacity and systems of 37 KP led CBO's, KP serving CSO's and PLHIV Networks from 18 districts of Maharashtra, for self-reliance and sustained response to HIV/AIDS for the key populations (FSW, MSM, PLHIV, PWID) and PLHIV population.

The key activities included organization self-assessment, planning and prioritization, capacity development plan, mentoring and handholding support, training of the CSO's in thematic areas.

The salient feature of the project was involvement of Maharashtra State AIDS Control Society (MSACS) as key partner in Epic project. The project was scaled up from 17 CSOs and 10 districts to 37 CSOs and 18 districts of Maharashtra.

The specific support in areas of resource mobilization and branding and visibility was rendered to selected CSO's /CBO's through involvement of two expert technical partners.

## 2) Project " School Chale Hum" with the Support of YARDI Solutions Pvt Limited :-

The project " School Chale Hum" with the Support of YARDI Solutions Pvt Ltd has been initiated in six clusters of Pune Municipal Corporation Yeravada, Vadgaon Sheri, Dhanakvadi, Karve Nagar, Shivaji Nagar, and Hadapsar from June 2024.

The project aims to ensure consistency and the continuity in non-institutionalized orphan children's studies (age group 13-23) and behavioral change communication in the families and community environment.

A total of 131 children from 88 households were supported for educational sponsorship during the period under report.

The key activities included baseline survey, data collection and data analysis, selection of deserving households and children for educational support, meetings with children and parents.

The parent and children meetings proved to be an effective platform both for parents and children to share their thoughts experiences and views.

**3) Educational Support Project for non-institutionalized children of Palghar District (age group 13-17-children who have lost single or both parents during COVID 19 pandemic) with the support of R. V. Naik Memorial Trust - IDBI Trusteeship Services Limited Satara :-**

A total of 52 children of 45 households (age group 13-17), from the blocks of Vikramgad, Wada, Palghar and Vasai were supported for educational sponsorship during the period under report.

A total of 101 children of 81 households from Palghar district of Maharashtra were supported for educational sponsorship during the years 2023- 2025 with the support of R.V.Naik Memorial Trust - IDBI Trusteeship Services Limited Satara.

The key activities included baseline survey, data collection and data analysis, selection of deserving households and children for educational support, Follow up of Households/children deprived support under various Govt. Schemes.

**4) Community Action For Health (CAH) Project with support of National Health Mission (NHM) and Technical support by State Health Services Resource Centre(SHSRC) :-**

Virtual discussions with village health volunteers and Sarpanch from the project villages were held during the period under report.

The external audits of community action for health project for the year 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 were conducted during 2024-2025.

5)The project for supporting health and education initiatives for non-institutionalized orphan children (age group 13-17) who lost the both/single parents due to COVID 19) for Palghar district of Maharashtra was approved by SHCIL Foundation India Trust Mumbai during the period under report. The project activities will commence in financial year 2025-2026.

**Resource Mobilization :-**

STAPI is grateful to all its donors and partners for their valuable support during the period under report.

**Linkages & Networking with Other Organizations:**

STAPI has strong linkages and networking with several partners viz NGO Networks across Maharashtra, Central & State Government Agencies - State Family Welfare Bureau, ZillaParishads , District Health Officers, Panchayat Samitis, and Experts from the State Health Services, State AIDS Control Societies, and management institutions.

The geographical network has greatly enhanced STAPI's outreach and as a result of which many NGOs have been able to access STAPI Services. STAPI also has a good network with the donors, well-wishers, members of projects advisory committees and volunteers.
