The Governing Council of SOSVA Training and Promotion Institute (STAPI) takes great pleasure in presenting its Twenty Second Annual Report together with the audited statements of accounts for the financial year 2021-2022.

STAPI as a support service organization, continued to offer a wide variety of services to the NGOs in Maharashtra, maintaining a close association with all its partnering organizations and partner NGOs during the period under report. For the Twenty Second year in succession, STAPI continued its systematic efforts for increase in its outreach and upgrading the scope and quality of services it offers to the NGOs.

They ear witnessed initiation of 5 new projects.

- 1) EpiC Project on technical assistance (TA) in organizational development (OD) for 14 civil society organizations (CSOs) in two PEPFAR priority districts of Maharashtra, namely Thane and Pune from (9 from Thane and 5 from Pune) with the support of FHI 360
- 2) America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Project for COVID 19 vaccination of PLHIV's and networks and NGOs /CBO's working with key population in non clusters in Satara Sangali Kolhapur and Solapur districts of Maharashtra
- 3) Project Phoenix for support to COVID 19 affected families in the areas of health education and livelihood from Thane district of Maharashtra
- 4) Integrated Village Development Project Village Suksale Block Vikramgad District Palghar
- 5) Rajiv Aaajeevika Samvardhan Abhiyaan (RASA) Project for Pune & Yavatmal Districts of Maharashtra

Meetings of Governing Council and General Body of the Society:-

The Governing Council met on 6 occasions during 56th; 57th; 58th; 59th; 60th and 61st Governing Council Meetings held on 21/8/2021; 18/9/2021; 16/10/2021; 15/01/2022; 19/2/2022 and 19/3/2022 respectively

The 21st Annual General Meeting of STAPI was held on 16/10/2021 Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic majority of the meetings were held virtually

II) About Projects:-

1) Community Action For Health (CAH) Project with the support of National Health Mission (NHM), Mumbai and Technical support by State Health Services Resource Centre (SHSRC)

The focus and emphasis of CAH project is communitization of key village institutions and strengthening of village health sanitation and nutrition committees and village health volunteers and activation of Village Health Gramsabha's aiming at community ownership with more accountability and responsive behavior by the local population in assuring accessible and affordable public health services to ensure no one left unattended.

The project activities included district and block based project activities by the district partner NGOs; consultations and review meetings with officials of NHM, AGCA, SHSRC district and block level administration, district partner NGOs and state planning and monitoring committees. The details of project activities are further illustrated below.

- i) Initiation of help desk for providing timely primary health care and COVID -19 relevant care and treatment services with an objective of complementing and supplementing the public health services during COVID 19 pandemic. A total of 20 Help Desks were setup in 8 districts of Maharashtra (Thane, Palghar, Raigad, Nandurbar, Nasik, Ahmednagar, Chandrapur and Gadchiroli)
- ii) Identification of Village Health Volunteers :-The process of identification of the local village health volunteers was underway during the period under project. A total of 374 Village Health Volunteers were identified in 8 districts of Maharashtra
- iii) Details of virtual trainings conducted as a part of CAH project are illustrated below:-
 - 1) Virtual awareness training on COVID 19 preventive measures, COVID19 appropriate behavior and vaccination for District Nodal NGOs, PRI Members, ASHA and Anganwadi Workers of 17 Project Partner NGO'S of Community Action For Health by Dr. Ahefaz Mulanai on 12/05/2021
 - 2) Virtual training in COVID 19 Preventive vaccination-registration to vaccination through Help Desks by Dr. Ahefaz Mulanai on 18/06/2021
 - 3) Virtual Webinar on CORONA Free Village Hiware Bazar by Padamshree Popatrao Pawar for PRI Members, ASHA, Anganwadi Workers of 17 District Partner NGOs of Community Action For Health Project on 29/5/2021
 - 4) Virtual Session with PRI Members, ASHA, Anganwadi Workers and 17 community action For health project partner NGOS for understanding needs of PRI members on issues of health hesitancy jointly organized by STAPI and AGCA on 1/6/2021
 - 5) Virtual Session for sharing of experiences of PRI Members, Members of VHSNC, ASHA's, Anganwadi Workers and village health volunteers regarding COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy jointly organized by STAPI and AGCA on 10/6/2021.

2) Project SWAVALAMBAN:-

The project for integrated community empowerment of fisherman community at Samata Nagar, Village TardobachiWadi, Block Shirur, District Pune started in April 2017 came to an end in March 2022.

The activities included sensitization in COVID-19 preventive vaccination and COVID - 19 relief work, health initiatives for community members, entrepreneurship development trainings of 130 SHG members, educational support to the children, and entrepreneurship training sessions.

A) COVID 19 Relief work was in following 3 broad categories:-

- a) Supplementing the Government efforts, to support the poor families, migrant and homeless population
- b) Awareness and sensitization of local population about prevention, hygiene, mask wearing, social distancing, quarantine, isolation and combating stigma
- c) Distribution of food supplies, dry ration or any other edible provision to those who lost their daily wages, the poor families, migrant and vulnerable and homeless population
- i) Sensitization of communities through E- Messages/ through IEC and BCC flex and banners/Social Media about the strict adherence to SMS –(a) Maintaining social distancing (b) Mask Wearing and (c) Regular Hand Wash (d) Providing referral services and availment of Government schemes during COVID-19 in 10 villages of Tardobahchiwadi, Golegaon, ChavanWadi, Karde, Shindodi, Nimone, Gunat, Motewadi, Amdabad and Shirur Gramin of Shirur Block of Pune district Covering 25000 population
- ii) Setting up Help desks at Shirur Block Hospital and Karde PHC's during April-July2021

B) Health Initiatives:-

- i) Two COVID-19 preventive vaccination camps for the age group 18 - 50 at GramPanchayat Tardobachiwadi and at Samtanagar Tardobachiwadi on 24/6/2021 and on 26/10/2021 respectively
- ii) Blood Donation Campin association with Ruby Hall Clinic Pune at GramPanchayat Chavan Wadi on 27/6/2021
- iii) Health Check Up and Medical Consultation at Samtanagar Tardobachiwadi

C) Education/Academic Support:-

- Conduct of cluster based informal teaching sessions for 60 children (age group 7-14 and 52 children (age group 0-6) to sustain children's interest in school education
- Collaborative education initiative with School Management Committee of Tardobachiwadi for distribution of books and supplementary food to the children of 1st–4th standard
- Conduct of cluster level classes for the children of 1st–7th Standard of Golegaon Zilla Parishad school with CAB adherence
- BCC sessions with the 14 children from 8– 10th standard for resuming schools with relaxation of COVID19 adherence norms
- Education Support of Rs.2,78,000/- under tribal scholarship scheme on the eve of 75 years of celebration of India's Independence

D) Women Empowerment:-

- Seven SHG's and 80 SHG members (including one male group of 20 Men) were part of SHG activities.
- Second time support by ICICI Foundation 5 SHG's / 52 SHG Members with a loan of Rs.12,99,000/-only.
- Handing over boats to the 7 Women from 4 SHG's as a part of support for their socio-economic empowerment on 11/5/2021.
- The 80 women from 7 self-help groups are engaged in fishing. The fish waste have been used as organic manure from Fish Waste. 12 women covering 5 SHG's have started fish compost units (Per unit cost is Rs.4513/-) and the same is being sold @ Rs.20/- per liter.

3) Targeted Intervention Project "DOSTI" Bhivandi Block, Thane District:-

Activities like conduct of Health checkup Camps; Advocacy Meetings, Demand Generation activities, mid media activities and Congregation events were organized during the period April 2021 - November 2021. The Project was handed over to Maharashtra State AIDS Control Society in December 2021.

4) Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) Project:-

Under the USAID-funded Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) Project, FHI 360 selected STAPI as a Lead Partner in implementing EpiC Project on organizational development (OD) and technical assistance (TA) of 14 civil society organizations KP led CBO's (9 from Thane and 5 from Pune) in two PEPFAR priority districts of Thane and Pune of Maharashtra since June 2021.

The project focus is on capacity development of CSOs, CBOs & NGOs working for the key HIV populations (FSW, MSM, PLHIV, PWID) to effectively manage and implement HIV programs and to support resource mobilization to enable them to contribute to HIV response in their districts and states on a sustained basis.

The Project activities included introductory meetings of partner NGOs, conduct of organizational self-assessment using the E-CAP tool, preparation of capacity development plans (CDP) of partner NGOs, mentoring visits and capacity building of partner NGOs in specific area of financial Management and review meetings with FHI 360.

The USAID Team visited Mahila Vikas and Shishu Sanskar Kendra (MVASSK) Thane Epic Project Partner during the period under report. The details of EpiC Project Partner NGOs are at Annexure-3.

5) America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Project:-

STAPI as a implementing partner was entrusted there's possibility of addressing vaccine hesitancy and promoting access to COVID-19 vaccines and supporting safe and uninterrupted access to HIV services and commodities for key populations (KPs) and people living with HIV (PLHIV) through collaboration with four PLHIV networks and NGOs /CBO's working with key population in non-cluster districts of Satara, Sangli, Kolhapur and Solapur.

The project activities included COVID-19 preventive vaccination of 60KP's and PLHIV's as per the inclusion criteria approved by USAID. Total of 6 community champions from non-cluster districts of Satara (1),Sangli (2),Kolhapur (1) and Solapur (2) actively supported in COVID-19 preventive vaccination. More details on community champions are at Annexure - 4.

6) Support Agency – Jal Jeevan Mission Block Shirur District Pune:-

STAPI was selected as a Implementation Support Agency for Har Ghar Nalse Jal in 60 villages (54 GramPanchayats (GP)) of Shirur Block of Pune District for the first Phase October 2021-July 2022. The various project activities included sensitization of local population about different aspects of the Jal Jeevan Mission, capacity building of VHSNC members, conduct of GramSabha awareness sessions with SHG women and GramPanchayat Members on various aspects of water such as rain water harvesting, water quality, water-borne diseases, water saving, drinking water source sustainability, training of VHSNC Member sin water testing using field test kit, capacity building of locally out has plumber electrician, pump operator for cost effective operation and maintenance, co-ordination between District Water Sanitation Mission (DWSM) and village health sanitation nutrition and water committees (VHSNC) and assistance in community led water campaigns initiated by Government of India/Maharashtra State Government to name a few.

7) Project Phoenix:-

The project Phoenix aimed at assessing and under standing the needs of COVID 19 affected families from Shahapur and Murbad blocks of Thane district. The project objectives were:-

- i. To provide the financial support to COVID 19 affected families in the areas of education, vocational Skills training, health and livelihood / income generation activities (who have lost bread earner and children who has lost parents/single parent/dear and near one's)during the pandemic
- ii. To advocate with the Government and Govt. apex organizations for linkages with COVID -19 specific campaigns /schemes and availment of other Government Schemes to COVID 19 affected house hold's from Shahapur and Murbad blocks of Thane district of Maharashtra.

The project activities included data collection through home visits, follow-up home visits, co-ordination with block and district level administration and support to deserving cases in the areas of education, vocational skills training, health and livelihood / income generation activities for the women from the COVID 19 affected families.

The project was supported by an individual donor, Shri Avinash Kenkare through Maharashtra Foundation, New York in January 2022.

Out of the total 65 families surveyed from Shahapur and Murbad blocks of Thane District (47 Shahapur and 18 -Murbad blocks), financial support was extended to 20 beneficiaries from 20 households (18 beneficiaries from 19 households from Shahapur and 2 beneficiaries from one household from Murbad block of Thane District).

8) Integrated Village Development Project Village Suksale Block Vikramgad District Palghar:-

UPS Express Private Limited Mumbai supported integrated village development project aimed at comprehensive and holistic interventions in the areas of health, women empowerment and livelihood / income generation activities in Suksale village of Vikramgad Block Palghar district during the period January 2022 – March 2023.

The community consultations with the local residents of Village Suksale were held in June 2021 and March 2022.

Baseline survey of 185 Households and focus group discussions with SHG members of 25 Women Self Help groups were conducted during March 2022.

9) Project Rajiv Aajeevika Samvardhan Abhiyaan (RASA):-

The objective of Rajiv Gandhi Foundation supported RASA project was to provide technical mentoring support to 50 aspiring micro entrepreneurs (who are rural residents and migrant returnees) each from Pune and Yavatmal (Implementing partner Eklavya Trust, Yavatmal) districts of Maharashtra.

The district mentors were sensitized and trained virtually about RASA programme, aspiring micro entrepreneurs (EMA's) aspects virtually during the period under report. The onsite and holding support was provided to aspiring micro entrepreneurs during August 2021- March 2022. Rajiv Gandhi Foundation supported for setting of digital resource libraries in Pune and Yavatmal districts of Maharashtra.

10) Project Maharashtra Alliance Young Adults (MAYA):-

The brainstorming meeting on after care programme with the officials of VATSALAYA Trust Mumbai was organized at STAPI on 2/9/2021.

Resource Mobilization:-

STAPI is grateful to all its donors and partners for their valuable support during the period under report

Linkages & Networking with Other Organizations:-

STAPI has strong linkages and networking with several partners viz. NGO Networks across Maharashtra, Central and State Government Agencies-State Family Welfare Bureau, State Health Systems Resource Centre, Zilla Parishad's, District Health Officers, Panchayat Samiti's, Experts from State Health Services, State AIDS Control Societies, and management institutions.

The geographical network has greatly enhanced STAPI's outreach and as a result of which many NGOs have been able to access STAPI Services. STAPI also has a good network with the donors, well-wishers, members of Advisory Committee, Members of Screening Committee and Volunteers.

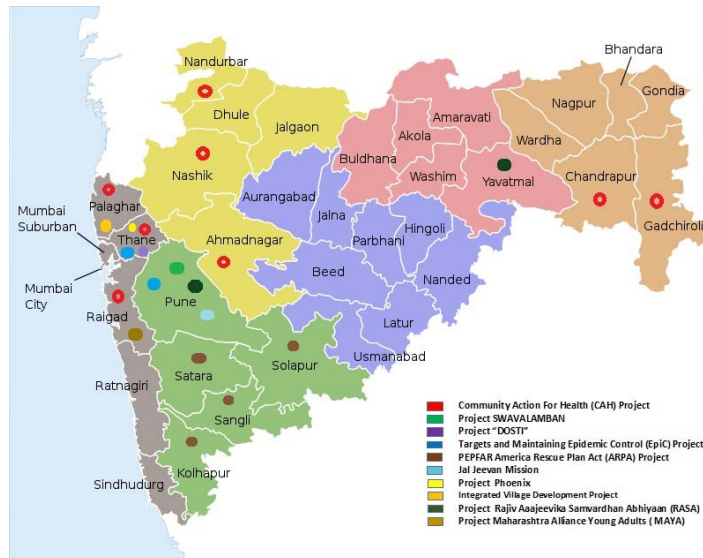



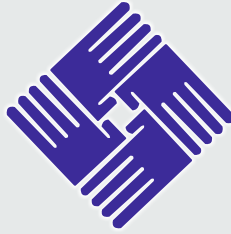
